By Train

Rainham Station is served by C2C trains operating between London Fenchurch Street (24 mins) and Southend in Essex (54 mins). Trains depart every 15 minutes during peak travel times.

By Underground

The closest Underground station is Dagenham Heathway, served by the District Line (Zone 5), which is only 15 minutes from CEME Conference Centre by bus (Bus 174) or taxi.

By Bus

Bus 174 operates every 10 minutes from Harold Hill via Romford and terminates at CEME Conference Centre on Marsh Way. Bus 287 operates from Barking to the junction of Marsh Way for CEME Conference Centre and the old A13 (30 mins).

By Car

Access to CEME Conference Centre is well signed from the A13:

A13 from London. Leave the A13 at the second Dagenham/Hornchurch exit. At the first roundabout take the fourth exit underneath the flyover and then take the

exit for Marsh Way at the second roundabout. CEME Conference Centre is the first turning on the left.

Al3 from the East. After the M25 junction leave the Al3 at the first Dagenham/Hornchurch exit. At the roundabout take the first exit, Marsh Way, and CEME Conference Centre is the first turning on the left.
